REAR TRAILING ARM INNER BUSH

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Contents (parts per pack):

2 x Polyurethane Bushes 2 x Zinc Plated Mild Steel Washers


2 x Stainless Steel Sleeve 1 x PTFE/Silicone Grease

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.
- -All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Remove original bush, and clean away any dirt or corrosion, alongside filing away any sharp edges.
- 2. Push each polyurethane bush into the bore of the arm, one on each side, until the brim of each bush sits on the side of the arm
- 3. Apply some of the supplied grease to the outside of the Stainless Steel Sleeve.
- 4. Slide the sleeve into the bore of each bush, ensuring that it is all the way through and sits flush on the outer edge of both polyurethane parts.
- 5. When refitting the rear trailer arm, place a supplied washer on both sides of the bush. Tension all hardware to manufacturers recommended torque settings.
